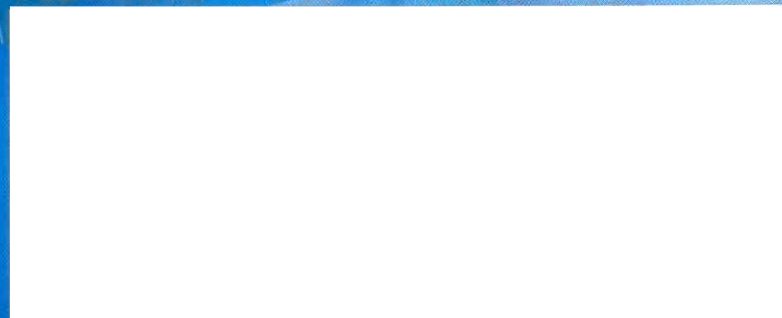

JC Henry, 80, founder of MTI Whirlpools, died Dec. 14. He founded the company under the name Mr. Tubs in 1988 after a career path that ranged from machinist to collections agent. He may be best known professionally for his invention of the patented Fill-Flush system, a self-cleaning system for whirlpool tubs. When he retired in 2001, he sold his company to a group of 20 employees, who renamed the company MTI Whirlpools.

Jack Bittner, 86, former publisher of *The Wholesaler* magazine, died Dec. 14 after a lengthy battle with cancer. He was well-liked and respected throughout the industry.

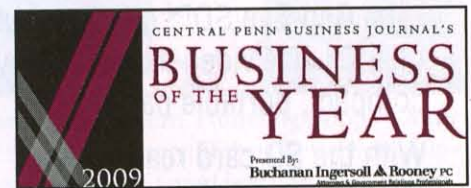
